

HOW CAN I APPLY?

You can apply when the registration link for a cohort is open.

As we have some support for the program, the program is free and we do not take any equity in any business trained. Nevertheless, we expect full commitment from our participants. Therefore, we take a down-payment of Ghc100.00 in the case of acceptance. We transfer this money back to you when you participated at all touchpoints of the program.

LANGUAGE?

The program will be conducted in English.

HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN RUNNING THIS PROGRAM?

The 2 weeks short course is a novel training program, while our one-year Training, Incubation and Funding began in August 2016. Here you find our alumnis from our program.

HOW IS THIS PROGRAM INDIVIDUALLY DESIGNED?

The experts and mentors who are working with the female founders in the batch will focus on each business individually and work with you in small groups. This is why you will need to carefully prepare the tasks assigned by the experts.

WILL YOU BE ABLE TO GET ME INTROS TO CORPORATES/INVESTORS?

The Female Founder network consists of countless corporates, business angels, VCs and other important contacts. We will introduce them on an individual basis if this is important for the growth of your business.

WILL THERE BE A DEMO DAY?

Yes there will be a demo day. However: expect no big spectacle or crowd. We will invite a smaller but more relevant crowd to an investors meetup and make sure you talk in depth with all people that are interesting for you. Please note that this Demo Day is constant through out our short courses or long training programs.

WHAT ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS?

After completing the online application, our Admin Team will shortlist a group of Applicants based on objective criteria. We will schedule calls with all applicants for further clarifications. The acceptance/rejection feedback will be sent out shortly afterwards.

HOW CAN I GET FUNDED BY UWAT?

At the end of the 3 months incubation program, there will be a final pitch whereafter, participants are selected for funding based on objective criteria.
